MHSAA

- MHSAA / NFSH DO NOT CHANGE RULES DURING A SCHOOL YEAR
- You must have completed the rules meeting to officiate (if you completed in August/September 2025 you are all set)
- Enter your MHSAA schedule at the MHSAA.COM website
- You must mark yourself AVAILABLE via the MHSAA website My-MHSA > Availability
- The postseason deadline is April 8th

WMYSA PRE GAME CHECKLIST

- Home Team is responsible for payment
- Before every game, both coaches shall provide the referee a current WMYSA Official Roster, Game Sheet
- Teams must present pass cards for Coaches and Player participating in game (presentation Risk Management Card is required for all Coaches).
- If a team uses the Pass Card System (PCS), they must hand write the player's name(s) and DOB(s) on the game sheet, before presenting to the official.
- All PCS players must present their current WMYSA Player Card at team check in. PCS players without a physical Player Card will not be permitted to play.
- Coaches from teams must be aware that PCS Players are being used in a game.
- Check in each team using the provided Player Cards against the Game Sheet or Official Roster.
- Maximum number of player PCS passes used is 5 per game (Elite Division is restricted to 3 player PCS passes per game)

WMYSA POST GAME CHECKLIST

- On completion of the game use the QR code below to enter the Match Report information.
- Accuracy and details count as this is how WMYSA verifies rules were followed, document issued cards, and any player injuries.
- Be sure to update/note coach and player absentees and add any player pass players.
- Add comments or details to any issued cards and/or player injuries.
- If teams do not have game sheet or pass cards this needs to be noted as well.

Whisper Weekend Campaign

Rate the coach, players and parents separately.

Rate on a scale of 1-3

- 1 = Poor, problematic, needs attention
- 2 = Average, no real problems
- 3 = Exemplary behavior, no issues or complaints

Any rating of 1 to a group, be sure to leave a comment.



WMYSA Match Report

- Coaches must enter all pass-card players onto the game sheet. If they haven't, please give it back to them to complete.

Referees should not be entering player details.

- Submit game reports to **sportsforms.club/wymrsa.html**
- Complete the details in Arbiter – please do not enter see Sports Form reports; I do not have access to them
